



THE BIOLOGY DECK

A Symbolic Physiology of Living Systems

84 cards / 12 living operations / 4 regulatory states

Function before metaphor. The body becomes a language for understanding any living system.

How the Deck Works

The Biology Deck begins with actual function: biological function -> lived experience -> psychological pattern -> archetypal function -> relational meaning -> spiritual or mythic meaning -> divinatory movement.

It is an oracle of systems, not a predictive or medical diagnostic device. Its primary question is: **What is the system trying to do?**

Regulation states

Deficiency: Too little access to the principle.

Coherent expression: The principle functioning proportionally within the whole.

Excess: The function rigid, overactivated, or separated from context.

Transformation: The movement that restores responsiveness.

Provenance

Biology-derived meaning, traditional correspondence, and original synthesis are kept distinct. Cultural material is named and sourced. No anonymous universal tradition is invented.

Reading Methods

The Homeostatic Loop

A five-card reading for regulation, teams, conflict, and adaptive decisions.

1. Variable - what must stay viable? / 2. Sensor - what is noticing change? / 3. Controller - what interprets the signal? / 4. Effector - what can act? / 5. Feedback - what must be measured again?

Metabolism

For projects, information, grief, food for thought, and organizational resources.

1. Intake / 2. Breakdown / 3. Assimilation / 4. Storage / 5. Expenditure / 6. Release

Circulation

For reciprocity, money, attention, care, and stalled movement.

1. Source / 2. Outflow / 3. Exchange bed / 4. Return path

Organ Conversation

A relational reading built from card-to-card biology.

1. First function / 2. Second function / 3. What passes between them / 4. The whole-body request

Body Map

A five-position spatial reading.

1. Head - sense and interpretation / 2. Chest - exchange and commitment / 3. Abdomen - transformation / 4. Pelvis - generation and release / 5. Limbs - action and contact

Repair Sequence

For recovery without pretending repair is linear.

Uses the deck's regulation states instead of reversals.

Brain



BIOLOGICAL ROLE

Brain integrates sensation, memory, emotion, prediction, and action across distributed neural networks.

ESSENCE

integration without total control.

ARCHETYPE The Council / The Messenger

Meanings

Psychologically, Brain describes integration without total control. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of receive, transmit, interpret, and coordinate information.

In relationship, this card examines whether integration without total control is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Cerebral Cortex

BIOLOGICAL ROLE

Cerebral Cortex supports conscious perception, language, planning, abstraction, and voluntary action.

ESSENCE

layered interpretation.

ARCHETYPE The Cartographer / The Messenger

Meanings

Psychologically, Cerebral Cortex describes layered interpretation. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of receive, transmit, interpret, and coordinate information.

In relationship, this card examines whether layered interpretation is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Limbic System

BIOLOGICAL ROLE

ESSENCE

felt significance.

ARCHETYPE The Remembering Animal / The Messenger

Meanings

Psychologically, Limbic System describes felt significance. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of receive, transmit, interpret, and coordinate information.

In relationship, this card examines whether felt significance is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Cerebellum

BIOLOGICAL ROLE

Cerebellum fine-tunes movement, timing, balance, and learned coordination through continuous error correction.

ESSENCE

mastery through adjustment.

ARCHETYPE The Rehearsal / The Messenger

Meanings

Psychologically, Cerebellum describes mastery through adjustment. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of receive, transmit, interpret, and coordinate information.

In relationship, this card examines whether mastery through adjustment is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

ESSENCE

the indispensable minimum.

ARCHETYPE The Gate of Wakefulness / The Messenger

Meanings

Psychologically, Brainstem describes the indispensable minimum. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of receive, transmit, interpret, and coordinate information.

In relationship, this card examines whether the indispensable minimum is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Brainstem presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of the indispensable minimum. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

BIOLOGICAL ROLE

a living message.

ARCHETYPE The Herald / The Messenger

Meanings

Psychologically, Neuron describes a living message. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of receive, transmit, interpret, and coordinate information.

In relationship, this card examines whether a living message is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Neuron presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of a living message. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

In relationship, this card examines whether the listening governor is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Hypothalamus presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of the listening governor. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

Psychologically, Pituitary describes small signal, systemic consequence. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of set pace, threshold, proportion, and feedback across the whole.

In relationship, this card examines whether small signal, systemic consequence is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Pituitary presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of small signal, systemic consequence. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

DEFICIENCY	poor feedback, weak cues, or inability to alter pace

inner time attuned to outer light.

ARCHETYPE The Night Clock / The Steward

Psychologically, Pineal describes inner time attuned to outer light. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of set pace, threshold, proportion, and feedback across the whole.

In relationship, this card examines whether inner time attuned to outer light is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Pineal presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of inner time attuned to outer light. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

In relationship, this card examines whether the pace of becoming is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Thyroid presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of the pace of becoming. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

ESSENCE

minute calibration of essential reserves.

ARCHETYPE The Calibrator / The Steward

Psychologically, Parathyroids describes minute calibration of essential reserves. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of set pace, threshold, proportion, and feedback across the whole.

In relationship, this card examines whether minute calibration of essential reserves is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Parathyroids presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of minute calibration of essential reserves. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

ARCHETYPE The Sentinel Forge / The Steward

Psychologically, Adrenals describes mobilized reserve. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of set pace, threshold, proportion, and feedback across the whole.

In relationship, this card examines whether mobilized reserve is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Adrenals presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of mobilized reserve. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

ESSENCE

influence through receptivity.

ARCHETYPE The Invisible Envoy / The Steward

Psychologically, Hormones describes influence through receptivity. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of set pace, threshold, proportion, and feedback across the whole.

In relationship, this card examines whether influence through receptivity is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Hormones presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of influence through receptivity. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

Heart



BIOLOGICAL ROLE

Heart creates rhythmic pressure that receives venous blood and sends it through pulmonary and systemic circulation.

ESSENCE

reciprocity through circulation.

ARCHETYPE The Living Pump / The Circulator

Meanings

Psychologically, Heart describes reciprocity through circulation. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of circulate, trade, and renew across living interfaces.

In relationship, this card examines whether reciprocity through circulation is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Heart presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of reciprocity through circulation. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

DEFICIENCY	isolation, stagnation, under-supply, or inability to receive
COHERENT	mutual movement in which giving and receiving sustain the whole
EXCESS	overextension, leakage, forced reciprocity, or circulation without rest
TRANSFORMATION	Restore movement by following the organ's actual logic: give, receive, and send onward.

Divination

Heart appears when the question is less "What will happen?" than "What is this living system trying to do?" Its answer is reciprocity through circulation.

"What must keep moving in order to remain alive?"

Action: Give, receive, and send onward.

Relationships: Lungs, Blood, Breath

Traditional correspondences

Classical Chinese medicine: The heart is described through a ruler/center metaphor and associated with shen and joy; presented as a historical medical-cosmological correspondence, not modern anatomy.

Galenic tradition: Later summaries of Galenic psychology associate heart with irascible emotion and vital spirit.

BIOLOGICAL ROLE

Lungs exchange oxygen and carbon dioxide across an immense folded surface while supporting acid-base balance.

ESSENCE

mutual exchange with the world.

ARCHETYPE The Twin Bellows / The Circulator

Meanings

Psychologically, Lungs describes mutual exchange with the world. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of circulate, trade, and renew across living interfaces.

In relationship, this card examines whether mutual exchange with the world is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

Spiritually, Lungs presents ordinary embodiment as a disciplined practice of mutual exchange with the world. Its mystery is not escape from biology but attention to the intelligence already present in living matter.

DEFICIENCY	isolation, stagnation, under-supply, or inability to receive
COHERENT	mutual movement in which giving and receiving sustain the whole
EXCESS	overextension, leakage, forced reciprocity, or circulation without rest
TRANSFORMATION	Restore movement by following the organ's actual logic: make room by exhaling fully.

Divination

Lungs appears when the question is less "What will happen?" than "What is this living system trying to do?" Its answer is mutual exchange with the world.

"What must enter, and what must leave, in the same breath?"

Action: Make room by exhaling fully.

Relationships: Heart, Diaphragm, Blood

Blood



BIOLOGICAL ROLE

Blood a moving tissue that transports gases, nutrients, wastes, signals, heat, clotting factors, and immune cells.

ESSENCE

belonging through circulation.

ARCHETYPE The Red River / The Circulator

Meanings

Psychologically, Blood describes belonging through circulation. It asks how a person or group performs the living operation of circulate, trade, and renew across living interfaces.

In relationship, this card examines whether belonging through circulation is mutual, timed, and proportionate. It asks what this function receives, what it gives, and what conditions let it work.

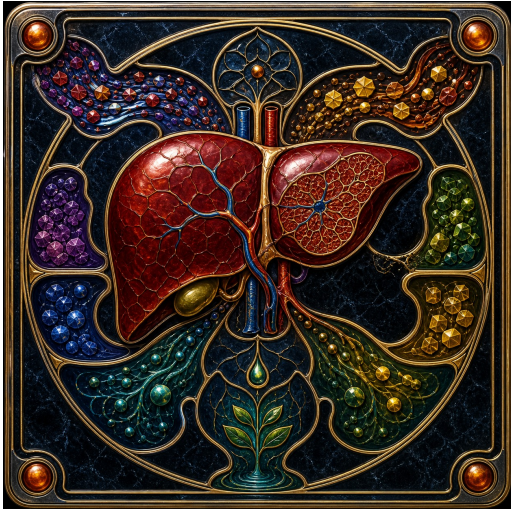
